



SWIMMING POOL

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

❑ **When is the swimming pool open?**

The swimming pool is heated and available year-round. Occasionally exceptions occur due to safety requirements and/or weather conditions.

❑ **What are the hours?**

The pool is open Tuesday through Sunday, 7:30am until the golf shop closes unless a lifeguard is on duty.

❑ **Is there a lifeguard on duty?**

Lifeguards are on deck Memorial Day through Labor Day, 11am to closing. After Labor Day, lifeguards are not on deck, but the pool is still available by checking in at the Golf Shop to receive a pool key and sign a waiver agreeing to the pool policy.

❑ **Who can use the pool?**

Members and guests may use the pool. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12 and/or not having an adequate swimming ability.

❑ **Can I bring guests to the pool?**

Yes. Guest fees apply for non-members. The guest fees are \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for children.



POOL RULES

1. All Members and Guests must sign in with the lifeguard on duty, at the Golf Shop or at the podium.
2. Members are welcome to bring guests. A non-member (adult or child) may not be a guest more than 6 times in a given calendar month.
3. Guests must be accompanied by the member at all times.
4. House Guests: Guest fees and the 6 times a month limit is waived for any member's temporary house guest that resides more than 50 miles from the Club. Please clear these out of town house guests with the club's manager in advance.
5. Members are responsible for the conduct of and any charges incurred by the members of their household and their guests.
6. Guest Fees will be charged to the member's account (no cash).
7. Guest Fees: Adults \$5.00 a day / Children (under 18) \$3.00 a day
8. No outside food or beverage shall be allowed in the pool area except when special dietary needs exist or for pre-arranged special event cakes.
9. Only swim suits and swim diapers may be worn in the swimming pool. Standard diapers, cut-offs or gym trunks are not allowed.
10. Loud, rowdy or raucous behavior is not allowed. The lifeguard staff has authority to decide what constitutes rowdiness. Lifeguards are empowered to suspend privileges if rules are broken.
11. No running on the pool deck at any time.
12. Inflatable and pool toys must be approved by lifeguard staff.
13. No glass containers are allowed on the pool deck.
14. ***NON-SWIMMERS: El Macero Country Club requires U.S. Coast Guard certified flotation devices for all non-swimmers.***

***The Lifeguards are at the pool primarily to provide a safe and fun environment for all and, as such, they are responsible for enforcing the rules. As a member it is your responsibility to be familiar with the rules and to make sure that you, your children, and your guests adhere at all times. The expectation from club management is that parents are responsible for supervising their children at the pool, and that all lifeguard requests are followed.**

~Guidelines~

‘Members Only’ to Host Poolside Parties

Length of time: three hours maximum – pool and lifeguard close at 7:00pm
~Parties of 50 or more are negotiable on finish time – must rent lights if after dark~

Fees

Guest fee (age 17 and under): \$3 per person

Guest fee (age 18+): \$5 per person

\$3 per person for set up, tables, chairs, plates, cups, event needs

\$2 per person cake service/outside dessert fee

\$50 for every extra hour over the allotted three

All Catering must come from El Macero Country Club – with exception of cake/cupcakes

Food and Beverage

Parties under 15 guests: Must order from the Snack Bar (cash or member charge only)

Parties over 15 guests: Must have a pre-selected menu for their event. The Banquet Manager will coordinate with you on menu selection. A server is required for all events over 15 guests.

Additional Guidelines

No outside food or beverages allowed

Birthday cakes and/or cupcakes charged a \$2 per person set up fee

No cutoff jean shorts allowed

Must sign a contract/BEO if a special menu is required,
or if private area is to be held or pool closed early

MEMBERS: Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult
in the pool area and locker rooms

NON-MEMBERS: Must use the changing room and restrooms at the pool

NON-SWIMMERS: El Macero Country Club requires U.S. Coast Guard certified
flotation devices for all non-swimmers.
